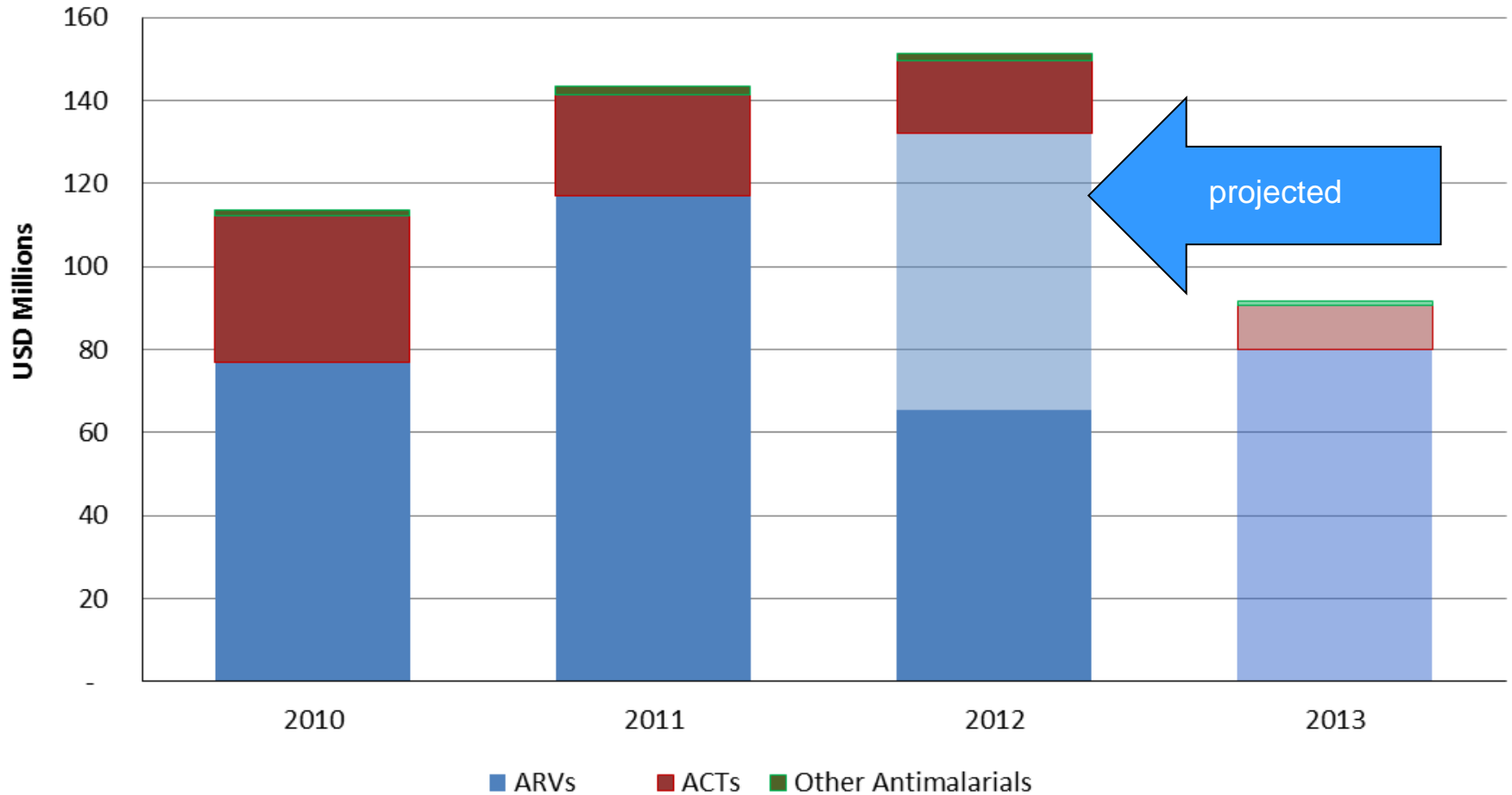

## UNICEF PROCUREMENT 2010 – 2013



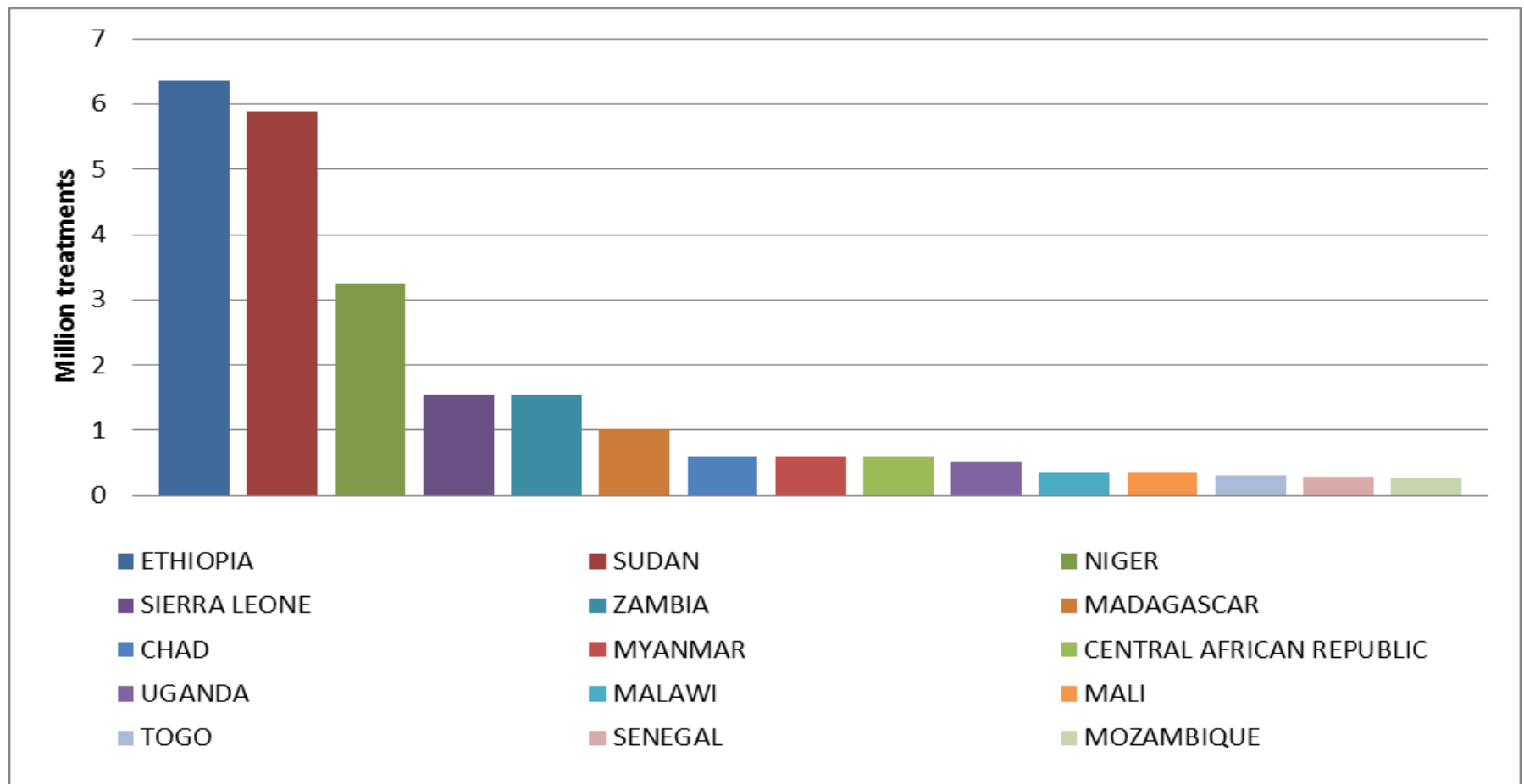

# UNICEF procures ACTs on behalf of 25-30 countries annually

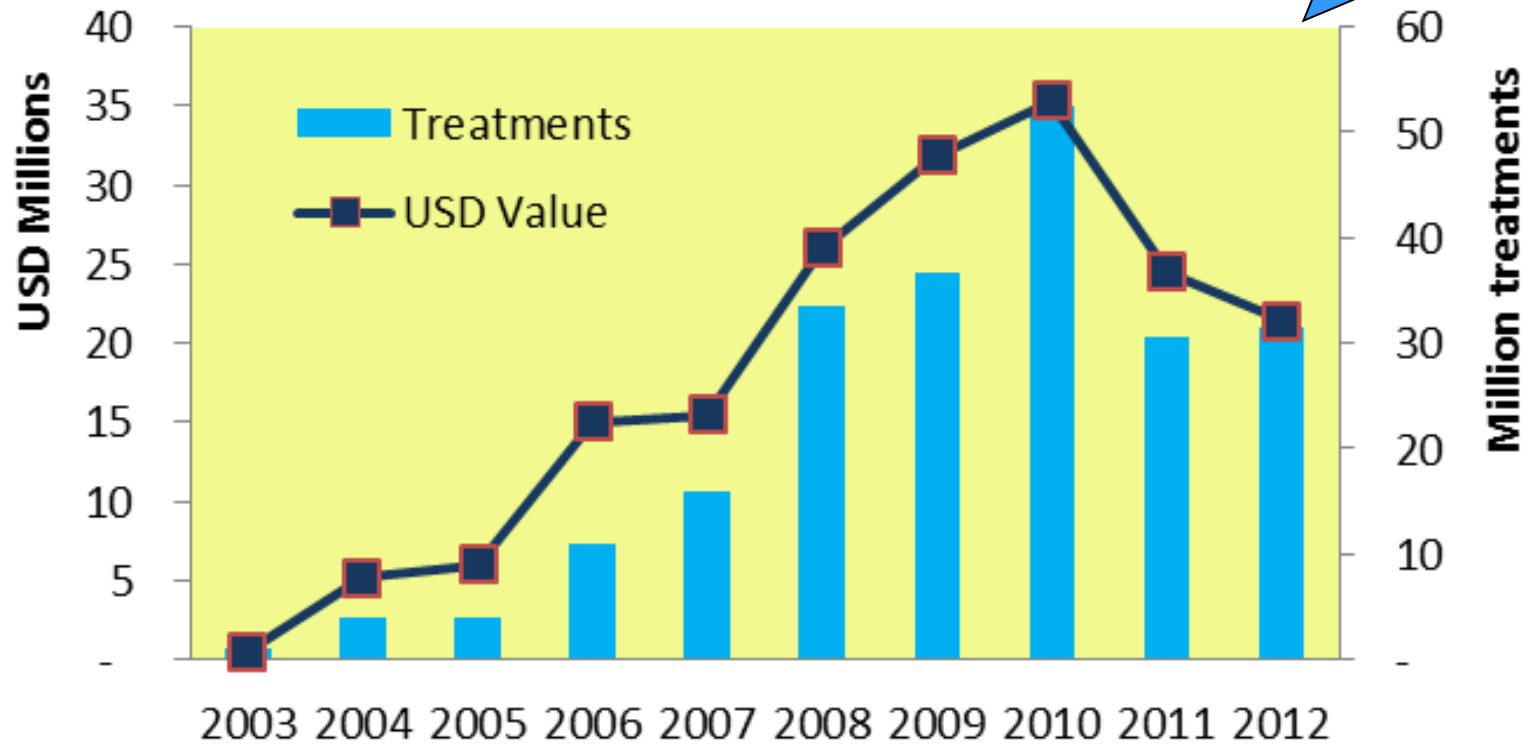

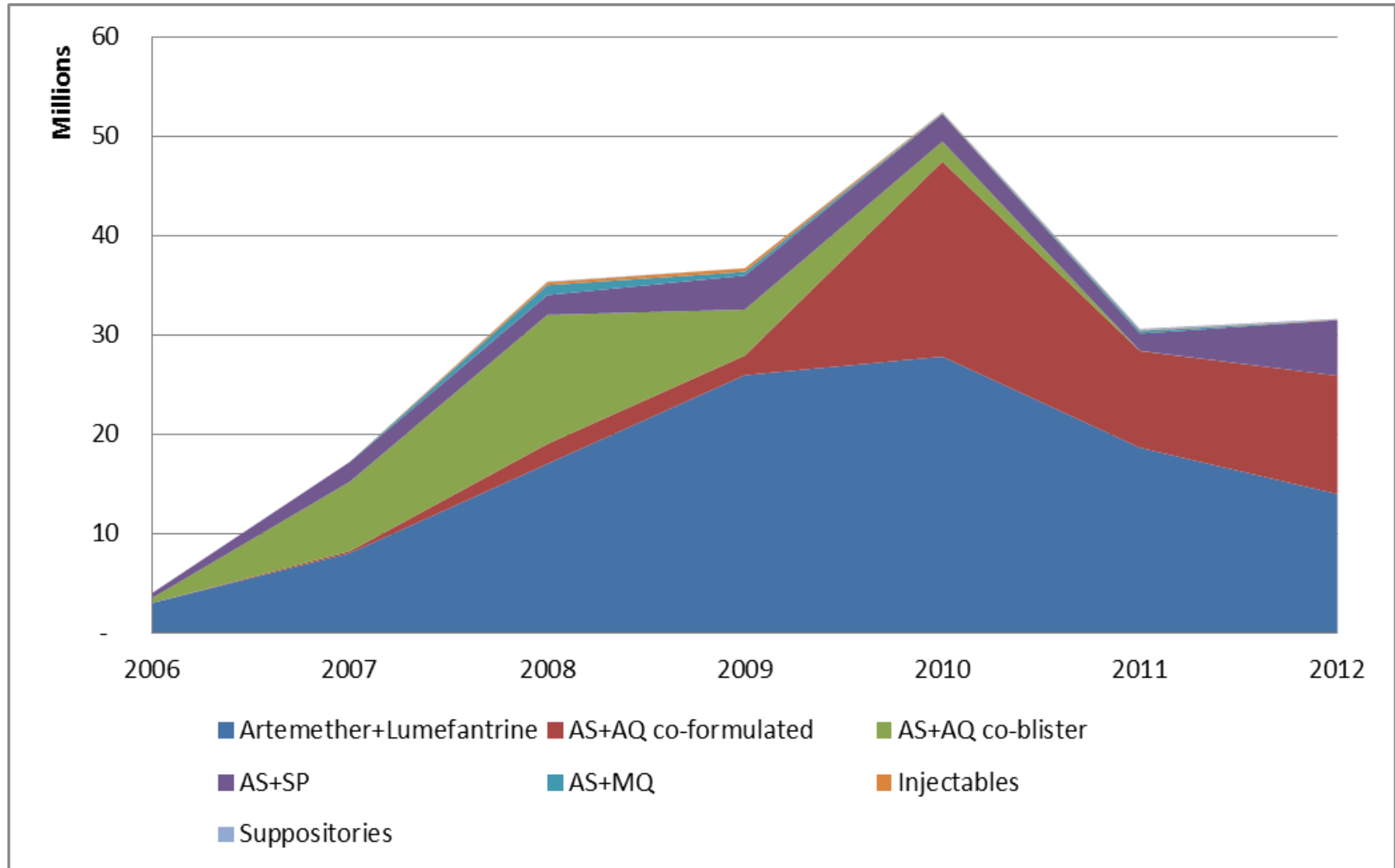

# UNICEF Procurement of ACTs: Volumes

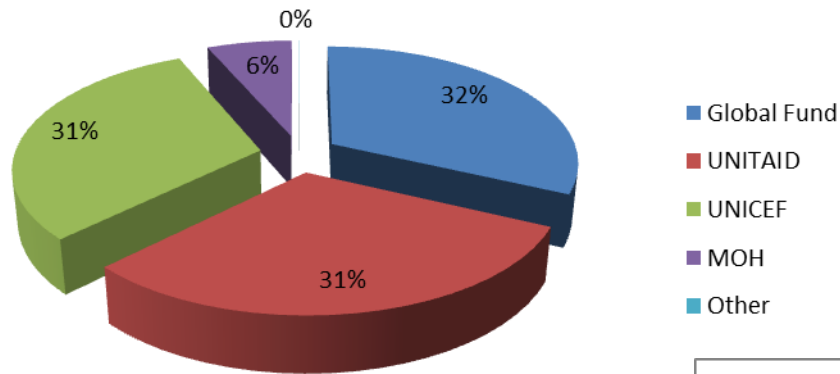

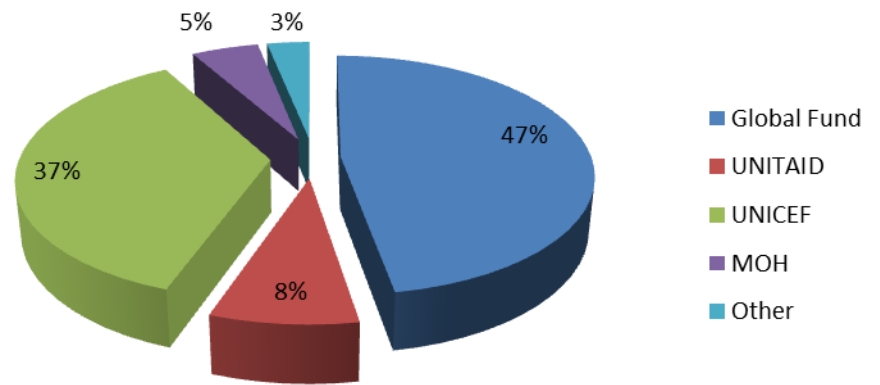

## ACTs PROCUREMENT STRATEGY

- Joint WHO - UNICEF tendering process
  - Annual RFP exercise (current 2012 cycle on going)
  - WHO PQ plus joint technical evaluation of offers
  - Fit for purpose review
- Multiple framework agreements (referred to as LTAs) established to ensure flexibility and availability.
- Allocation of orders: secondary competition
- Screening of requisitions based against treatment guidelines
- Regular sharing of forecast with LTA holders
